Holy Spirit	John 16:13	But when He, the Spirit of Truth comes, He will guide you into all truth. He will not speak on His own; He will speak only what He hears, and He will tell you what is yet to come.
Anger	Proverbs 15:1	A gentle answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger.
Serving	1 Peter 4:10	Each one should use whatever gift he has received to serve others, faithfully administering God's grace in its various forms.

Great Commandment	Matthew 22:37-40	Jesus replied, "Love the Lord your God with all your soul and with all your mind. This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: Love your neighbor as yourself. All the law and prophets hang on these two commandments."
Humility	Micah 6:8	He has showed you, O man, what is good. And what does the Lord require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God.
Worldliness	Galatians 5:24	Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the sinful nature with its passions and desires.

Dedication Romans Do not offer the parts of your body

your body to Him as instruments of
righteousness.
