Topic	Reference	Verse
Way of Salvation	John 14:6	Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me."
Way of Salvation	Acts 4:12	"Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we much be saved."
Salvation	1 Peter 3:18	For Christ died for sins once for all, the righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God.
Salvation & works	Ephesians 2:8-9	For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—not by works, so that no one can boast.
Salvation	1 John 5:11-13	And this is the testimony: God has given us eternal life, and this life is in His Son. He who has the Son has life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have life. I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, so that you may know that you have eternal life.

Response to Christ	John 1:12	Yet to all who received him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God.
Assurance of Salvation	John 10:27-28	My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; no one can snatch them out of my hand.
Assurance of Salvation	John 10:29-30	My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all; no one can snatch them out of my Father's hand. I and the Father are one.
Eternal Life	John 6:40	For my Father's will is that everyone who looks to the Son and believes in him shall have eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day.
Love	John 13:34-35	A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this all men will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another.
Acceptance	Romans 15:7	Accept one another, then, just as Christ accepted you, in order to bring praise to God.
Forgiveness	Ephesians 4:32	Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ, God forgave you.

Fellowship	Hebrews 10:24-25	And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds. Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another – and all the more as you see the Day approaching.
Believer's Example	1 Timothy 4:12	Don't let anyone look down on you because you are young, but set an example for the believers in speech, in life, in love, in faith, and in purity.
Believer's Conduct	Philippians 1:27	Whatever happens, conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ. Then, whether I come and see you or only hear about you in my absence, I will know that you stand firm in spirit, contending as one man for the faith of the gospel.

Believer's Speech	Ephesians 4:29	Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen.
Believer's Speech	Matthew 12:36-37	But I tell you that men will have to give account on the day of judgment for every careless word they have spoken. For by your words you will be acquitted and by your words you will be condemned.
Body is God's Temple	1 Cor. 6:19-20	Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own, you were bought at a price. Therefore, honor God with your body
Witnessing	Prov. 11:30	The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life, and he who wins souls is wise.
Discipleship	2 Tim. 2:1-2	You then, my son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus. And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses, entrust to reliable men who will also be qualified to teach others.
Discipleship	1 Thess. 2:8	We loved you so much that we were delighted to share with you not only the gospel of God, but our lives as well, because you had become so dear to us.
